Architecture in Wales

National Eisteddfod of Wales Ceredigion

1 – 8 August 2020



An exhibition of recent architecture to be held at the **National Eisteddfod of Wales, Ceredigion** supported by the **Design Commission for Wales** and the **Royal Society of Architects in Wales**.

Exhibition entries are invited from architects, or group of architects, for buildings whose practical date of completion was between 1 January 2017 and 1 March 2020.

Successful entries for inclusion in the exhibition will also be considered for the two following prestigious awards:

The Gold Medal for Architecture

(Alwyn Lloyd Memorial Medal)

Supported by the Design Commission for Wales

A silver-gilt replica of the original gold medal will be awarded to the architect or architects responsible for a building, or group of buildings, completed between 1 January 2017 and 1 March 2020 and recommended to the Eisteddfod as being of greatest merit.

Plaque of Merit

To honour smaller projects of a high standard of design.

Architects are invited to submit either newly built or refurbished projects that satisfy the following criteria:

- constructed in Wales
- final account of up to £750,000
- completed between 1 January 2017 and 1 March 2020
- enhances the environment

Entries for 2020 will be selected by Niall Maxwell (Rural Office for Architecture, Carmarthen) and Zoë Quick (Architect and Educator, Llanidloes).

The exhibition aims to enhance the profile of architecture in Wales through the presentation of drawings and models, selected for their quality and their ability to convey the richness of architecture and its value to the culture of Wales.

Architecture in Wales is realised in partnership with the **Design Commission for Wales** and the **Royal Society of Architects in Wales**.
